**PROSECUTION'S SUPPLEMENT OF ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE RELATED TO
SECOND MOTION FOR ADMISSION OF EVIDENCE FROM THE BAR TABLE**

1. The Prosecution hereby tenders additional evidence regarding the date and source of 35 exhibits admitted or partially admitted as directed by the Trial Chamber's "*Décision Relative à la Requête de l'Accusation aux Fins d'Admission d'Éléments de Preuve présentés directement sans l'Entremise d'un Témoin et de Modification de la Liste 65 ter des Pièces à Conviction*" of 23 December 2010 (Decision).¹ The Decision ruled on the Prosecution's Second Motion for Admission of Evidence from the Bar Table, first filed on 29 March 2010 and again on 17 May 2010.
2. The Prosecution tenders and includes on the CD attached as Annex A scanned versions of the documents from which the 32 exhibits originate, which show their source and date.² Annex B cross references the 32 exhibits to the scanned versions included on the CD.
3. Additional information is given in Annex B about the sources and dates of the video tapes including Video Rule 65ter 06018 and video clips Rule 65ter 06066 and 06021. Clips from the tapes of all three videos have already been admitted, and the Prosecution, on that occasion, informed the Trial Chamber about the tapes'
