**Cetnik – members of Serbian military organizations with extremely nationalistic and chauvinistic Great-Serbian objective. During 2nd World War openly collaborated with Nazis (German and Italian Nazis)*

**Oganj – M-77 Oganj is a multiple rockets launching system – 32 launching tubes of 128mm caliber. Service crew consists of 5 men and it is most commonly mounted on a truck FAP 2026.*
