URGENT

MAIN STAFF OF THE ARMY OF REPUBLIKA SRPSKA

Regular combat report.-

1. The enemy:

In the morning, on the Dubrovnik-Trebinje axis, the enemy opened tank fire on the sector of Veličani and positions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> pb /infantry battalion/ in the sector of Zelenikovac. He opened mortar fire on the villages of Gornji Sedlari and Grmljani.

In the afternoon, Ustashas burned down a co-op building in Čvaljina, torching houses in the villages of Šoše, Misite and Šćenov Do.

Enemy forces were observed arriving and regrouping.

On the Čapljina-Stolac axis, the enemy opened artillery fire on our positions in the sector of Ravnice, Mišljen and Ibrahim Do.

The enemy is regrouping and bringing new forces.

On the Mostar-Nevesinje axis, the enemy continued to move and regroup forces on the left bank of the Neretva.

At around 14:00 hrs, a strong artillery attack on the KM /command post/ of the brigade began from the sector of Crnići, Alidinići and Blagaj.

At around 18:00 hrs on 7 November, artillery fire also began from the right bank of the Neretva.

2. Situation with combat readiness:

There have been no significant changes in combat readiness. Units of the 10<sup>th</sup> Hmtbr /Herzegovina Motorised Brigade/ and the 23<sup>rd</sup> lpbr /light infantry brigade/ are successfully conducting attacking sectors with a high concentration of Ustasha forces and artillery and mortar VP /firing positions/.

3. Situation in the territory:

There have been no significant changes in the situation in the territory.

4. Extraordinary incidents:

There have been no extraordinary incidents.

5. Condition of morale:

Soldiers' morale has been positively impacted by the payment of salaries for September. By the end of the month, we should also pay salaries for October, since this is the only source of income for most soldiers.

6. Logistical support:

As per report on logistical support.

8. Predictions:

Based on operations so far and all available information, an increase in combat operations is expected on all sections of the frontline in Eastern Herzegovina war zone.

9. Requests:

As per report on logistical support.
