Regular combat report

1. The enemy:

In the morning of 10 November, on the Dubrovnik-Trebinje axis, the enemy opened strong artillery fire on the villages of Diklići, Popovo Poljice, Mareva Ljut, Dračevo, and Veličani.

He continued to burn down Serbian villages of Požarno, Baljevac, Misite and Trnovica near Vlaka.

By way of provocation, the enemy rained infantry fire on our positions in the sector of Bobani and Trebinje forest. During the day he only rotated troops holding positions.

On the Čapljina-Stolac axis, the enemy opened strong artillery fire on our positions in the sectors of Mišljen, Ravnice and Dvrsnik.

On the Mostar and Nevesinje axis, the enemy continued to conduct strong infantry attacks with strong and constant artillery and mortar support along the entire frontline (especially on the Hodovo-Brštanik axis).

2. Situation with combat readiness:

Units of the 10th Hmtbr /Herzegovina Motorised Brigade/ are preventing Ustasha forces from breaking through with persistent and on some axes decisive defence, as well as inflicting considerable losses on the enemy. We are increasing the manning levels of our units by demobilising personnel and deploying them on the frontline. Units of the *Foča* TG /tactical group/ are successfully conducting operations in keeping with the plan.

3. Situation in the territory:

There have been no significant changes in the situation in the territory.

4. Extraordinary incidents:

There have been no extraordinary incidents.

5. Condition of the morale:

The condition of the morale ensures the implementation of set tasks.

6. Logistical support:

Expenditure of types of ammunition has increased due to very intense combat operations, especially along the Mostar-Nevesinje axis. We are requesting replenishment in ammunition and fuel.

7. Losses:

During the reporting period, 11 soldiers were killed and 101 were wounded, the majority of them slightly.

8. Conclusions:

By engaging all available forces, the enemy continued to conduct attacks on all sections of the Eastern Herzegovina frontline, especially the Mostar-Nevesinje axis. Attacks are likely to continue tonight and tomorrow.

9. Requests:

As stated in yesterday's report.
