Dear Sir,

Further to the Chamber's request, dated 24 April 2009, for a weekly medical report on the diagnosed health problems of Mr Jovica Stanisic and further to my earlier report, dated 5, 11, 12, 18 and 26 May 2009. I would like to provide you with the following information.

Regarding Mr. Stanisic's presumed short period of unconsciousness on 24 May 2009; Dr. Falke found no neurological or cardiovascular abnormality upon examination, furthermore nor the ECG nor the MRI of the skull revealed any abnormalities. The diagnosis is that is was vago-vasal reflex.

Mr. Stanisic's back pain is improving slowly.

The colitis is unchanged, his weight has not changed, urine test prove a positive energy balance.

The psychological situation is unchanged. His state of mind is depressed.

I therefore must conclude that Mr. Stanisic's general condition has improved slightly; Analysis of the presumed short period of unconsciousness showed no cerebral or cardiovascular abnormalities. Although his state of mind is depressed, in my opinion as general practioner, there are no evident psychiatric reasons preventing him participating in proceedings.

He is not fit to be transported.

He is not fit to sit for more than 10 minutes.

He is fit enough to participate in proceedings if sitting is limited to 10 minutes.

He is fit enough to participate in proceedings up to one hour in the bed that has been installed in the VTC room.

I will of course provide you with additional reports as requested and keep you informed of developments as they occur.
